It was a wonderful time of reunion with dear friends and family in our village. While we were away there were a few things that had happened to the house and truck that needed immediate attention so on Tuesday the 13th the work began. After almost a month back home, I'm happy to report that most all of those things are resolved and we are getting back into the swing of island living.
